

## MED 6920-Current Issues, Topics, and Practices in Education (Relicensure Course)

**The 2017 session will be held from  
Monday, May 1 through Saturday, May 6, 2017.**

The Utah State Board of Education (USBE) has authorized the Teacher Education Department at Weber State University to offer a six day master's level relicensure course. The course is MED 6920 "Current Issues, Topics and Practices in Education." It will provide participants 100, 150, or 200 licensure points based on how many days/sessions are attended.

### **Two step registration process:**

1. To register for this relicensure program, please contact Melinda Bowers, the Master of Education Administrative Assistant at [melindabowers@weber.edu](mailto:melindabowers@weber.edu) or by phone at 801-626-6278 with the following information: name, address, email address, phone number, licensure area (elementary, early childhood, secondary, or special education), the level of the license to be renewed, and the number of points you need to relicensure (check with the state for that number). She will then send you the introductory letter.
2. Here is the link to register for the course that you need <http://continue.weber.edu/professional/teachertraining.aspx>. Please scroll down until you find the correct course and CRN. Click on "Add to Cart" and pay the tuition. The specific credits and hours/days of attendance are based on the number of relicensure points needed (check with USBE for your individual amount).  
If you need to earn
  - 0-100 points register for 2 credit hours, and you must attend all six sessions during the first 3 days. The cost is \$956.00. (MED 6920 – CRN 1810 11705)
  - 101-150 points register for 3 credit hours, and you must attend all sessions during the first 3 days plus your choice of 3 of the remaining 6 sessions. The cost is \$1265.00 (MED 6920 – CRN 1810 11711)
  - 151-200 points register for 4 credit hours, and you must attend all 6 days/12 sessions. The cost is \$1575.00. (MED 6920 – CRN 1810 11718)
